Well, one thing is for sure Food for the Hungry is not just a name. We really do feed those that are hungry in our food ministry on Monday evenings. I saw it first hand. I worked recently in the ministry to substitute for Mike Cagle while he was in Nashville for the birth of a grandchild. I had not worked in the ministry for some time and was encouraged by what I saw while I was working.

I saw a tremendous response to our request for help. So many LR Church members came to work. Thanks to everyone! I saw members working together in the kitchen who did not know each other before that night. Ministry brings us together. Did you know that we have many people working in this ministry that are not even members of LRC. The head cook, Mrs. Joyce belongs to another church family in our community. One guy who was laid off from his job regularly serves because he received food through the ministry.

I saw us run out of food for the meal after serving about 200 people. It was sad to turn people away. I also saw us run out of boxes of food. I saw one family that had received a number to get a box of food give their number to another family that needed the food more. I was very touched by seeing this. (Don't tell Tommy but we gave them a box of food to make up for their act of kindness.)
