I was out of town last week at a meeting in Salt Lake City, Utah evaluating potential of church planters.

I would like to remind you again to be in prayer about our church planting efforts. At this point, we have no specific plans but we are in the process of asking God to raise up a church planter and a location for a church plant in central Arkansas. If you remember, part of LRC's vision statement is the planting of two more churches by 2015. Please join me in asking God to enlarge his Kingdom in Central Arkansas by planting new churches.

Church Planting Fact:

Dozens of studies have confirmed that the average new church gains most of its new members (60-80%) from the ranks of people who are not attending any worshipping body, while churches over 10-15 years of age gain 80-90% of new members by transfer from other congregations. This means that the average new congregation will bring 6-8 times more new people into the Body of Christ than an older congregation of the same size.
