Today will include a special offering to cover the expenses of this time. Our goal is \$8,500. Anything that is raised over this amount will go toward my Angola work fund, which will be used for outreach in Angola.

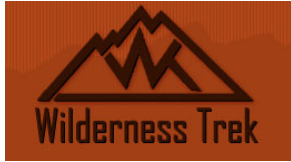
