Prayer?

Dear Lord, God, I've done all right. I haven't gossiped, haven't lost my temper, and haven't been greedy, grumpy, nasty, selfish, or over indulged. I'm very thankful for that. But in a few minutes, God, I'm going to get out of bed. And from then on, I'm going to need a lot more help. In Jesus name I pray, Amen.

Truly, prayer is very important to make it through each day. Let me ask you a basic question. If you were to define prayer in one sentence what would you write? My personal definition has changed over the years because of my study and experiences in prayer. In prayer, I have learned a lot about myself and my selfish ambitions. Today I define prayer in a very different way than I did twenty years ago. My definition is **prayer is seeking God's will in my life on His terms.**

Our sovereign God often makes the sovereign choice to accomplish His will only when asked to do so. God definitely has plans for our lives. Jeremiah 29:¹¹ *For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."*

We must be seeking Him and His will for the plans to be fulfilled. Matthew 6:9 *"Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven."* Later on Jesus tells His followers to seek God in all things. Matthew 7:⁷ *"Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you."* ⁸ *For everyone who asks receives; he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks, the door will be opened."*

We are seeking the happy life, the abundant life. If we are not willing to seek God in prayer at all times then how can we expect Him to open up the store houses of heavens with blessings?
