IMPORTANT DETAILS

- 3) Adult sponsors from LRC include myself, Angie King and Bonnie Chandler. There are two other youth groups there with adult sponsors.
- 4) We will leave Six Flags Saturday between 4-5 PM. Students will begin calling home when we reach Texarkana (~2 hours away).
- 5) Due to their work, who they minister to and their presence in urban Ft. Worth, there is a dress code for our students. Please refer to the packing list for those details.
